4. Lord Jesus, we recognise that our worship of you can often be half-hearted, we recognise that our walk as a disciple can be lukewarm. We need more of you Spirit to ignite our hearts in passion for you - come Lord Jesus! Amen.

Start doing

5. Think what changes do you need to make to put into practice a greater seriousness to follow Jesus?
