

Small Group questions:

In this passage, Jesus reveals that He has risen from the dead to a group of disciples who have met together in a home. Everyone eats together, and then Jesus explains how His resurrection relates to Scripture.

A key theme of the passage is how we interpret our experience in the context of Scripture.

We looked at how we can meet with Jesus in our homes, recognising that we all have very different experiences of home life. Our homes are our personal spaces; they are the places where ordinary day to day life happens.

We thought about how we may be able to turn the domestic into the spiritual, and looked at two ways this can happen

- by asking where is God in this
- by looking at what is happening and then looking at how it relates to Scripture.

1. What do you think of when you hear the word home?
2. Have you ever encountered the risen Jesus in your home?
3. We often pray about challenges, look at how Scripture may apply to them, but do you ever think/pray about ordinary domestic things and ask how Scripture may apply to that situation?
4. What more could you do to use the ordinary things of life to help you experience more of Jesus?
5. As we come out of Covid, how are you feeling about mixing with people?
6. Why do you think Jesus only appeared to a small group of people?
