



Key Points :

- Jesus is teaching his disciples after a rich man wanted to know how to enter the Kingdom of Heaven. The guy was willing to follow some rules but when it came to letting go of his money and going all-in, he wouldn't. Jesus describes this situation as 'impossible' (e.g. like a camel through an eye of a needle)
- But Jesus also teaches that with God, nothing is impossible (v.26) and because of this, he invites us to go all-in with him, not holding anything back. We can **practice the presence, join a group, serve in a team, and give financially.**

Questions:

Conversation Starter

1. What's your Springfield highlight of the past year?

Start Thinking & Sharing

2. 'With God everything is possible' is a wonderful truth. Why do you think we struggle to believe this?
3. How can we increase our expectation of what's possible with God? (i.e. going beyond what we've experienced)
4. What does it look like on an average day to go 'all-in' with Jesus?
5. In Mat 19.20-21, Jesus told the rich man he had to give away all his money. What might Jesus be asking you to let go of in order to follow him?

Start praying. Be bold, and pray specifically.

6. *Jesus, we want to follow you and we want to be part of the story you're writing through Springfield. Help us to grow in faith so that our expectation exceeds our experience and to let go of the things that are preventing us from going all-in. Amen.*

Start doing. Commit to a step, and live it out this week.

7. Make space today to spend time listening to Jesus and spending time in His presence. Ask Jesus to show you what you need to let go of or join in.
