

Talk summary:

Main point: The risen Jesus sets us free from disappointment to hope

Key verse: 'We had hoped he was the Messiah who had come to rescue Israel' Luke 24:21

Reading: Luke 24:13-33 (Road to Emmaus)

Overview: The two disciples on the Road to Emmaus were in deep disappointment. Their hopes were dashed, they didn't know what to do. Jesus gave them hope - he revealed himself through scripture, his own presence and the breaking of bread. He still does that today and takes our disappointments and pours in hope, whatever we are facing.
