



Talk summary:

How God's love looks like a healed hand [Luke 6:1-11]

1. The man's crippled right hand was healed [Luke 6:10]
 - a) The man was healed instantly
 - b) Jesus wasn't afraid to show love and care to others when he saw they needed it most
 - c) For us sometimes healing doesn't happen when or in the way we'd expect
2. Jesus didn't just heal a man's hand, but did it on the Sabbath [Luke 6:6, 9]
 - a) This was a Holy Day, a special day. Old testament law stated you couldn't do many things on that day
 - b) Jesus saw the man's need - something needed to be done, irrespective of day, time
 - c) Is it better to help or ignore, to step out in faith and see what God can do or just walk away?
3. Stepping out in faith
 - a) God wants us to be the kind of people who are willing to step out and pray, regardless of where / when / with who
