- 4. Volunteers can sign up for a period of time if they prefer and we can allocate roles for example those who help with welcoming guests could then help with serving or clearing tables. There are also a few one-off jobs not on the list.
- 5. We can also offer a meal to those volunteers who would like one this will be confirmed nearer the time.
- 6. Once we have all the information from the various churches, we will confirm receipt of the volunteer list you have sent us. We will then contact the volunteers directly. There will be a short meeting for all volunteers, the week before the lunch.
